Dear Parent/Guardian,

The purpose of this letter is to draw your attention to two specific forms in this packet:

1. The Kentucky High School Athletic Association Physical Exam and Parental Consent Form
2. The General Permission Form

While parents are expected to complete all admission forms, these two forms are especially important if your child wants to join a team. In order for your student to gain the most from our program, we need your cooperation. Our school is a member of the KHSAA and we are responsible for making sure all of our student-athletes adhere to its bylaws.

These forms must be updated every school year. They cannot be carried over from year to year. It is in your child's best interest to have these forms completed and returned on the day of admission. Having the paperwork already done will allow him/her to participate immediately. Even if your child has never shown an interest in athletics before, he/she may find opportunities here that other schools did not offer.

The KHSAA form requires that the physician fill out one portion. You and your child must fill out the rest. The General Permission Form must be completed by you. It has medical and insurance information that coaches carry with them throughout the season in the event your child has to receive medical attention at a competition.

In order to expedite your child's eligibility, please have the physical exam and paperwork completed **BEFORE** your student starts school. Your child will not be permitted to participate on any team until all eligibility requirements are met.

If your child must receive a physical through the school, he/she may be delayed in starting practice until an appointment can be made. There will be a \$25 fee charged to your account that will not be filed through your medical insurance company.

Thank you for your cooperation, and I look forward to working with your child in our athletic program.
